



Mr. Cary Cannon

May 19, 1945 - August 6, 2015

Funeral service for Mr. Cary Cannon, 70, of Auburn will be held at 11:00 am Thursday, August 13, 2015 at Peterson and Williams Chapel with interment in Fort Mitchell National Cemetery. Rev. Annie Ruth Cannon will officiate.

Mr. Cannon passed away Thursday, August 6, 2015 at the Veterans Administration Medical Center in Decatur, GA. He was a member of Zion At The Hill A.M.E. Zion Church where he served as chairman of the Trustee Board. In 1964, he graduated from Tuskegee Institute High School. Following graduation, he entered the U.S. Army, serving during the Vietnam War. During his tenure in Vietnam, Mr. Cannon was awarded a Purple Heart and two Bronze Stars. He furthered his education at Wenonah State and graduated in brick masonry. After thirty-two years, he retired from Uniroyal Goodrich Inc..

The family will receive family and friends at the funeral home this evening at 6:00 pm.

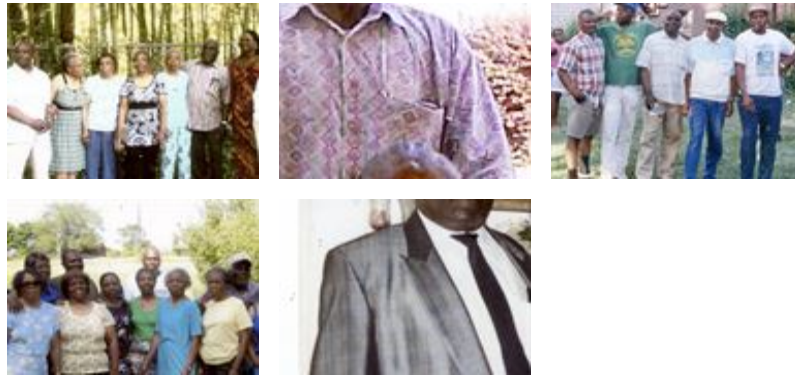
