Funeral service for Mr. Charles Luke, 88, of Salem, AL will be held at 12:00 noon Thursday, July 14, 2022 at Nazareth Missionary Baptist Church with interment in the church cemetery. Rev. S. Dwayne Drakeford will officiate. Masks are required. Mr. Luke passed away Wednesday, July 6, 2022 at East Alabama Medical Center. He was a faithful member of Nazareth Missionary Baptist Church. For over twenty (20) years, he served as chairman of the Deacon Board. For many years, he served as church treasurer, as a member of the senior choir, male chorus, cemetery committee, van driver, custodian and groundskeeper. In 1954, Charles was drafted into the US Army where he served two years. Upon his return, he attended East Street School in Opelika, AL and received his high school diploma. Later, he attended Auburn University College of Business where he received a supervisory certificate preparing him for a supervisory role at Opelika Foundry. After forty-three (43) years of dedicated service to Opelika Foundry, he retired. Mr. Luke was also a member of the Nazareth Masonic Lodge #927 and served as Worthy Patron of the OES Adkins Pride #876A.

Public viewing will be held Wednesday from 4:00-6:00 pm. His remains will lie in state at the church one hour prior to the service.
