When our work on earth is done, We must cross the bridge of rest.*

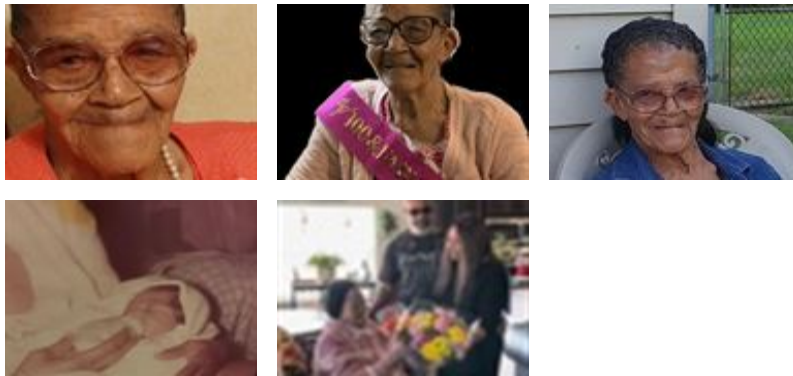
