Upon her return to Auburn, she was employed at Lee County Hospital (now East Alabama Medical Center), Opelika, AL. She later moved to Syracuse, New York, where she was employed at General Electric as a Machinist for twelve years. Due to family illnesses she returned to Auburn and worked at Diversified Products for eleven years

and retired from Tuskegee National Forest

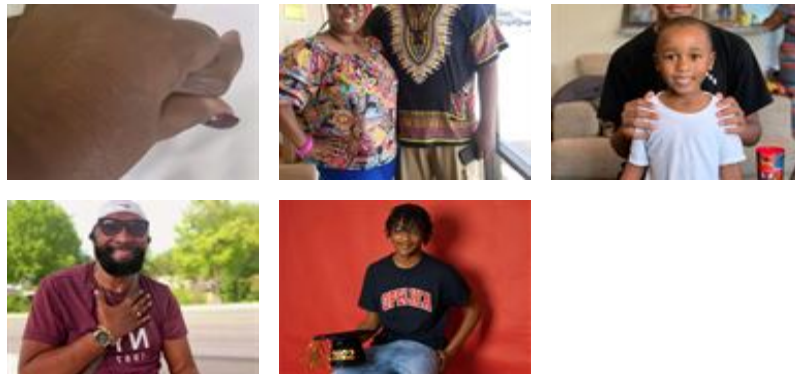
