Robert Anthony Jeter, known by many as “Ant” was born on November 7, 1966 in Tuskegee, AL, at John A. Andrews Hospital to Robert Anderson and Evelyn Virginia Jeter. He is the eldest of four children. Ant began his early childhood at St. Joseph Catholic School (class of 1981) and graduated from Tuskegee Institute High School with the class of 1985. He pursued higher learning at Tuskegee University, receiving his B.S. in Agricultural Business Education as well as being commissioned as Second Lieutenant into the United States Army in 1991. When the opportunity presented itself, he continued to further his education by completing a M.A. in Education at Alabama A&M University.

Anthony was joined in holy matrimony to his college sweetheart, Joyce Denice Powe on December 29, 1990. To this union, three beautiful daughters were born, Ashley, Antinia, and Anajulia.

On Saturday, April 5, 2014, Robert Anthony “Ant” Jeter completed his earthly journey.

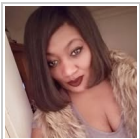
