Funeral service for Mr. Robert Ingram “Tootie” Maddox, 61, of Alexandria, VA and formally of Opelika will be held at 1:00 pm Monday, April 13, 2015 at St. Luke A.M.E. Church with interment in Evergreen Cemetery. Rev. Eugene Johnson Jr. will officiate.

Mr. Maddox passed Thursday, April 2, 2015 in Alexandria, VA. He was a member of First A.M.E. Church and a former member of St. Luke A.M.E. Church. In 1972, he graduated from Opelika High School. After twenty years of service, he retired from the U.S. Army. He furthered his education at the University of the State of New York at Albany where he earned a B.S. Degree and later a Master’s Degree from Troy State University. Mr. Maddox was a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. Prior to his passing, he was the owner of Maddox Consulting Inc.

A family hour will be held Sunday at 4:00 pm. His remains will lie in state at the church one hour prior to the service.

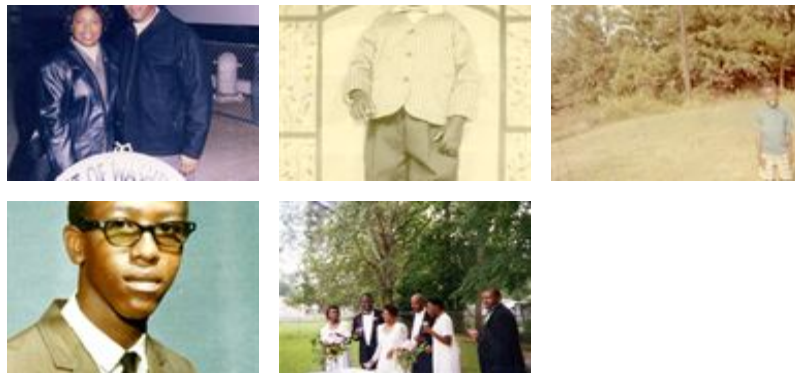
