In 1986 he received his BFA from The University of Florida and his MFA from The University of Texas at Austin in 1990. Steven taught art and sculpture classes at several colleges and universities in the states of Florida and Texas. He also worked abroad and in Haiti teaching workshops as an art ambassador. He returned to Auburn in 2013, after the passing of his father, Milton Jones Jr., to support and assist with caring for his mother.
